#### Statement of reason

These proposals are to facilitate the traffic movements accessing/leaving the New Welsh Medium school, Farm, Garden Centre & Care Home within the school site.

The eastern access road is substandard for two way traffic. By making the eastern access one way it enables a contraflow cycle way to be provided and entry from the A4139 Bush Hill will be prohibited.

Although the route through the school site is not adopted highway it does have full public access and therefore these movements / prohibitions are to be supported by a TRO.

- i) To permanently prohibit all vehicles except pedal cycles from proceeding along the unnamed eastern access road, from its junction with Bush Hill (A4139) to the junction with the internal connecting unnamed southbound road from the Henry Tudor School, other than in an Eastbound direction.
- ii) To permanently prohibit all vehicles from proceeding in a northbound direction on the unnamed road, between its junction with the unnamed eastern access road to the mini roundabout.
- iii) To permanently establish a contraflow cycle lane between the junction with Bush Hill to the junction with the unnamed southbound connecting road from the Henry Tudor School site.
- iv) To prohibit the left turn movement from the A4139 Bush Hill (Northbound) on to the unnamed eastern access road
- v) To prohibit the right turn movement from the A4139 Bush Hill (Southbound) onto the unnamed eastern access road

THE PEMBROKESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (Hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of the Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, Hereby make the following Order.

- No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or qualified Traffic Management Operative under instruction, cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to travel along the lengths of road set out in the Schedule 1 to this Order
- 2. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or qualified Traffic Management Operative under instruction, cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to travel along the lengths of road set out in the Schedule 2 to this Order
- 3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
- 4. This order may be cited as "The County of Pembroke (Welsh Medium School Access Road, Pembroke) (One Way Traffic (Except Pedal Cycles)) & Prohibition Of Left & Right Turn (A4139 BUSH HILL) Order 2024 and shall come into operation on the \*\* day of \*\*\*\* 2024

### SCHEDULE 1

### (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

Unnamed Eastern Access Road	To permanently prohibit all vehicles except pedal cycles from proceeding along the unnamed eastern access road, from its junction with Bush Hill (A4139) to the junction with the internal connecting unnamed southbound road from the Henry Tudor School, other than in an Eastbound direction.
Unnamed internal road	To permanently prohibit all vehicles from proceeding in a northbound direction on the unnamed road, between its junction with the unnamed eastern access road to the mini roundabout.
