The Order will further amend the "Pembrokeshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2011 and schedules contained therein and subsequent variations.

The effect of the proposals will be to introduce new, amend and/or revoke existing waiting restrictions on those lengths of road listed in the Schedule to this notice.

1 Haverfordwest

1.1 No waiting at any time

Cherry Grove

North side – from the eastern gable end of no. 25 Cherry Grove east to its junction with Queensway, a distance of approximately 15 metres.

South side – From the eastern gable end of no. 25 Cherry Grove north east to the junction with Haverfordwest High School access road, a distance of approximately 17 metres.

Ebenezer Row

North east side – from the eastern gable end of property of number 1, north west to the northern gable end of property number 4.

Queensway east

West side – from its junction with Cherry Grove, north for a distance of approximately 17 metres

2. Llangwm

2.1 No waiting at any time

The Kilns

North side – from a point 10 metres west of the centreline of The Gail westwards for 20 metres

South side - from a point 20 metres west of the centre of The Gail westwards for 55 metres

3. Llanreath

3.1 No waiting at any time

Victoria Road

East side – from a point 10 metres north east of the centreline of St Patricks Hill, south to its junction with the car park, a distance of approximately 100 metres.

West side – from its junction with St Patricks Hill south to a point 10 metres south west of the centre line of the car park, a distance of approximately 103 metres.

4. Pembroke

4.1 No waiting at any time

Bush Hill

West side – from a point 30 metres north of the centreline of Henry Tudor School exit road, north for 57 metres (lines already in place).

Buttermilk Close

Both sides – from a point 20 metres north of the southern junction of access road, northwards to its junction with the northern junction of the access road.

5. St Davids

5.1 No waiting at any time

High Street

South side – from the boundary of numbers 22/24 High Street east for 10 metres (amends current seasonal waiting restriction to all year round restriction).

Catherine Street

South east side - from the junction of Ramsay Gardens north east for 15 metres

Ysgol Penrhyn Dewi School access road

All sides – around the perimeter of the traffic island in front of the access to the school grounds

<u>6. Tenby</u>

6.1 Removal of No waiting at any time

Park Road

North side – From its junction with Penally Road, west for 53 metres (reduces existing restriction by 10 metres)

The Pembrokeshire County Council ('the Council') in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46,49, 53, 101, 102, 124 and part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended, the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") and of all other enabling powers of the Act, and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on the day of 202.. and may be cited as the Pembrokeshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2011 (Variation No. 29) Order 202.....
- The Pembrokeshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2011 ("the Consolidation Order") including the schedules contained therein and subsequent variations are hereby varied or amended as follows:-

1) Amendment of Schedule 2

(a) In Schedule 2.1, insert:-

Haverfordwest

Cherry Grove

North side – from the eastern gable end of no. 25 Cherry Grove east to its junction with Queensway, a distance of approximately 15 metres.

South side – From the eastern gable end of no. 25 Cherry Grove north east to the junction with Haverfordwest High School access road, a distance of approximately 17 metres.

Ebenezer Row

North east side – from the eastern gable end of property of number 1, north west to the northern gable end of property number 4.

Queensway east

West side – from its junction with Cherry Grove, north for a distance of approximately 17 metres

<u>Llangwm</u>

The Kilns

North side – from a point 10 metres west of the centreline of The Gail westwards for 20 metres

South side - from a point 20 metres west of the centre of The Gail westwards for 55 metres

<u>Llanreath</u>

Victoria Road

East side – from a point 10 metres north east of the centreline of St Patricks Hill, south to its junction with the car park, a distance of approximately 100 metres.

West side – from its junction with St Patricks Hill south to a point 10 metres south west of the centre line of the car park, a distance of approximately 103 metres.

Pembroke

Bush Hill

West side – from a point 30 metres north of the centreline of Henry Tudor School exit road, north for 57 metres (lines already in place).

Buttermilk Close

Both sides – from a point 20 metres north of the southern junction of access road, northwards to its junction with the northern junction of the access road.

St Davids

Catherine Street

South east side - from the junction of Ramsay Gardens north east for 15 metres

Ysgol Penrhyn Dewi School access road

All sides – around the perimeter of the traffic island in front of the access to the school grounds.

(b) Schedule 2.1 of the Order is amended as follows:-

St Davids

High Street / Cross Square, for paragraph relating to south side, substitute: From the boundary of Nos. 24/26 High Street, west to a point 7 metres west of the east boundary of 12 Cross Square.

Tenby

Park Road, for paragraph relating to North side (b), substitute: (b) From its junction with Penally Road west for 53 metres.

(c) In schedule 2.11 of the Order is amended as follows:-

High Street, for paragraph relating to south side, substitute: From the boundary of Nos. 24/26 to the east boundary of No. 32.


Statement of Reason

The proposals to introduce or amend on street parking restrictions as contained in the draft Order attached are being promoted as part of the Councils continual review of on street parking provision on the County road network.


